Case No.: 146265** Ms. Martin appeared without counsel to discuss her Application for Licensure by credentials to practice dentistry in the Commonwealth of Virginia, and the allegations set forth in a Notice of the Board dated October 5, 2012. The Committee received statements and additional evidence from Dr. Martin and discussed the allegations with her.

Martin. The motion was seconded and passed.

Reconvene: Ms. Swain moved that the Committee certify that it heard, discussed or considered only public business matters lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements under the Virginia Freedom of Information Act and only such public business matters as were identified in the motion by which the closed meeting was convened. The motion was seconded and passed.

Ms. Toliver reported that the Committee found Dr. Martin did not meet the requirements of § 54.1-2709 (C)(iv) of the Code of Virginia and 18VAC60-20-71(6) of the Regulations Governing Dental Practice in that she has not been in continuous clinical practice, which has consisted of a minimum of 600 hours of practice in a calendar year, for five out of the six years immediately preceding her application.

The Committee agreed to recommend to the Board that Dr. Martin's Application for Licensure by credentials to practice dentistry in the Commonwealth of Virginia be denied.

Dr. Gaskins moved to adopt the decision of the Committee. The motion was seconded and passed.
