**James Nottingham, DDS
Case No.: 141417** Dr. Nottingham appeared with counsel, R. Barrow Blackwell, to discuss the allegations set forth in a Notice of the Board dated January 15, 2013. The Committee received statements from Dr. Nottingham and Mr. Blackwell and discussed the allegations with them.

Closed Meeting: Ms. Swecker moved that the Committee convene a closed meeting pursuant to § 2.2-3711(A)(27) of the Code of Virginia for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of James Nottingham. Additionally, Ms. Swecker moved that Ms. Palmatier, Ms. Lee, and Ms. Toliver attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting is deemed necessary and their presence will aid the Committee in its deliberations. The motion was seconded and passed.

Reconvene: Ms. Swecker moved that the Committee certify that it heard, discussed or considered only public business matters lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements under the Virginia Freedom of Information Act and only such public business matters as were identified in the motion by which the closed meeting was convened. The motion was seconded and passed.

Ms. Toliver reported that the Committee found that between October 11, 2010 to September 17, 2011, Dr. Nottingham prescribed approximately 1,980 dosage units of Vicodin to Patient A, an individual he knew or should have known did not have legitimate pain associated with dental treatment and who was drug seeking.

The Committee also found that Dr. Nottingham practiced outside the scope of his dental education, training, and experience by treating Patient A's chronic back pain with approximately 1,530 dosage units of Vicodin between January 11, 2011 and September 17, 2011.

Dr. Nottingham failed to obtain an updated health history during his care and treatment of Patient A, and he also failed to include a diagnosis in Patient A's treatment record to explain the need for restorations performed on teeth #3, 13, 14 and 31.

The sanctions reported by Ms. Toliver were that Dr. Nottingham shall receive a reprimand and pay a \$10,000 monetary penalty. Dr. Nottingham's license shall be placed on probation subject to the terms and conditions that within 6 months from the date of entry of the Order he shall successfully complete 7 hours of continuing education in pharmacology and prescription writing.

Ms. Swecker moved to adopt the decision of the Committee. The motion was seconded and passed.

The sanction reported by Ms. Roukous was that Dr. Choudhary shall pay a \$500 monetary penalty.
