Corie Tilman Wolf, Assistant Attorney General, presented evidence that the continued massage therapy practice of Herbert Wamey, 0019-006912 may present a substantial danger to the health and safety of the public.

Ms. Hartz moved to summarily suspend the certificate of Herbert Wamey pending a formal administrative hearing and to offer a consent order for indefinite suspension of his massage therapy certificate, in lieu of a formal hearing. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.
