The meeting was called to order by Dr. Selig. With eight members of the Board and four members of the Committee of the Joint Boards of Nursing and Medicine participating, a quorum was established. A poll of those participating showed that a good faith effort to convene a regular meeting within the week was not possible.

Wayne Halbleib, Senior Assistant Attorney General, presented evidence that the continued practice of nursing by Joey Pascarella, RN, LNP 0001-154043; 0024-167336 may present a substantial danger to the health and safety of the public.

Ms. Hartz moved to summarily suspend the right to renew the RN multistate privilege of Joey Pascarella pending a formal administrative hearing and to offer a consent order for indefinite suspension of her registered nurse license, in lieu of a formal hearing. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

Ms. Gregory moved to summarily suspend the LNP license of Joey Pascarella pending a formal administrative hearing and to offer a consent order for indefinite suspension of her nurse practitioner license in lieu of a formal hearing. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:35 A.M.
