Wayne Halbleib, Senior Assistant Attorney General, presented evidence that the continued nurse aide practice of Anthony Johnson, 1401-146659, may present a substantial danger to the health and safety of the public.

Ms. Hartz moved to summarily suspend the nurse aide certificate of Anthony Johnson pending a formal administrative hearing and to offer a consent order for revocation of his certificate with a finding of abuse, in lieu of a formal hearing. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.
