**Meeting Goal: To gain insight on how mental health/substance abuse efforts help address these goals of the NHAS:**

**NHAS Goal 1, Step 2:** Expand targeted efforts to prevent HIV infection using a combination of effective, evidence-based approaches.

**NHAS Goal 2, Step 3:** Support people living with HIV with co-occurring health conditions and those who have challenges meeting their basic needs

**NHAS Goal 3, Step 2:** Adopt community-level approaches to reduce HIV infection in high-risk communities.

**Objective:** Gain knowledge on various mental health systems in Virginia that can help address the goals of NHAS.

**Objective:** Illicit information from presenters on how their services can help meet the NHAS goals.
