**SUBJECT:** Regulations for Standards and Specifications for Warning Stickers or Decals for All-Terrain Vehicles - 19 VAC 30 – 130 *et seq.*

In response to a request from the Virginia State Police, I have examined the current regulations which are up for periodic review, 19 VAC 30 – 130 *et seq.*, relating to standards and specifications for warning stickers or decals for all-terrain vehicles.

Virginia Code § 46.2-915.1 provides that the Virginia State Police shall approve a decal or sticker for all-terrain vehicles which clearly and completely states the requirements set forth therein. Upon review of the aforesaid regulations, I find the regulations to be constitutional, consistent with the statutory authority granted by Virginia Code § 46.2-915.1, and in conformity with existing statutory provisions.
