# VOSH Program Directive: 01-015A

## Issued: March 1, 1996

## Subject: State Plan Policies and Procedures Manual, (Through CH-5)

#### A. <u>Purpose</u>.

This directive adopts Federal OSHA Instruction STP 2.22A (through CH-3), State Plan Policies and Procedures Manual.

This Program Directive is an internal guideline, not a statutory or regulatory rule, and is intended to provide instructions to VOSH personnel regarding internal operation of the Virginia Occupational Safety and Health Program and is solely for the benefit of the program. This document is not subject to the Virginia Register Act or the Administrative Process Act; it does not have general application and is not being enforced as having the force of law.

### B. <u>Scope</u>.

This directive applies to all VOSH personnel and specifically to VOSH managers and supervisors.
