The procedures and boilerplate for permitting poultry incinerators are hereby promulgated for agency use in permitting poultry incinerators under state and federal rules (Chapter 40, Part II, Article 7, Emission Standards for Incinerators; Chapter 50, Part II, Article 4, Standards of Performance for Stationary Sources; and Chapter 80, Part I, Permits for new and modified stationary sources).

These procedures and the permit boilerplate were developed by Sharon Foley of the Valley Regional Office, were subjected to departmental peer review and comment under the proposed boilerplate management procedures, and were forwarded to me by the Air Permit Managers Group, which has reviewed and recommended the proposed procedures and boilerplate for use by the Department.

The procedures, an emissions calculation spreadsheet, and the boilerplate may be found on the Departmental file server (K:\Agency\Air_Permitting\Boilerplates) as follows:
