

**Rescue Squad Assistance Fund
Award Conditions**

Each grant award may be restricted by certain conditions. Conditions attached to grant awards are listed below. Refer to your Award Page for the condition(s) that apply to your specific award.

Condition Number	Description
1	Vehicle must be available for service 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
2	Agency must upgrade license to ALS.
3	Agency must obtain endorsement from OMD.
4	Results must be reported to OEMS.
5	Must be reviewed and approved by OEMS Communications Coordinator prior to purchase.
6	Must satisfy all ALS course requirements, and are subject to audit by OEMS.
7	Organization must become a licensed EMS agency.
8	Funding provided is for the purchase of an AED only.
9	Funding excludes 12-lead option.
10	Agency must upgrade to transport agency.
11	Computer awards require establishment of internet account; providing OEMS with agency e-mail address; electronic submission of PPDR & grant application as applicable.
12	Itemized quote must be submitted to OEMS for approval prior to purchase.
13	Acknowledgment must be provided on any printed material as follows: "Project made possible by a grant from the Virginia Office of Emergency Medical Services, Virginia Department of Health."
14	Defibrillator must be placed on law enforcement vehicle.
15	Defibrillator must be placed on emergency service vehicle.
16	Defibrillator must be placed on EMS permitted vehicle.
17	Funding for equipment only – no supplies will be reimbursed.
18	CISM awards must adhere to state guidelines (see attached).
19	Must work with Technical Assistant Coordinator.
20	Competitive bid process/RFP is required.
21	Special condition(s) - see attached.
22	Must be placed and remain in service at new station.
23	Must demonstrate successful completion of training program related to awarded item.
24	Must submit evidence of 12-lead protocol prior to purchase.
25	Must seek Public Safety Accreditation Program (PSAP)
26	Must meet current Heavy Tactical Rescue (HTR) extrication Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and seek approval from the OEMS Emergency Operations Division.
27	Must submit a maintenance/sustainability plan to the OEMS for awarded item.
28	Must be compliant with submitting EMS data including the minimum dataset prescribed technical format as required by Virginia Code §32.1-116.1.
29	Must use the Panasonic ToughBook 19 to comply with pre-hospital patient care reporting of the OEMS minimum dataset in the technical format prescribed by OEMS.
30	Agency must draw down previous grant funds prior to reimbursement of this award.
31	Agency must submit a statement of explanation of why previous grant funds were not drawn down prior to expiration of grant.
32	Agency must complete all vehicle information in the "manage vehicles" section of the VPHIB system, including all data elements within the vehicle information, station, purchase information, and vehicle status sections. If this vehicle is replacing another vehicle, the vehicle being replaced must be marked as "inactive" in the VPHIB system.
