Ms. Lane moved that the Board of Nursing reinstate the registered nurse license of Katherine Yeary. Upon resuming practice as a registered nurse, she be placed on indefinite probation with terms for a period of not less than one year.

The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

Ms. Piersall moved that the Committee of the Joint Boards of Nursing and Medicine deny reinstatement of the nurse practitioner license and further shall continue on indefinite suspension for a period of not less than one year.

The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

This decision shall be effective upon the entry by the Board of a written Order stating the findings, conclusions, and decision of this formal hearing panel.
