

**VIRGINIA BOARD OF NURSING
TELEPHONE CONFERENCE CALL
August 10, 2011**

A telephone conference call meeting of the Virginia Board of Nursing was held August 10, 2011 at 8:30 A.M. The Board members participating in the meeting were Patricia M. Selig, R.N., F.N.P., Ph.D., President; Evelyn Lindsay, L.P.N. Secretary; Allison Gregory, R.N., L.N.P.; Louise D. Hartz, Citizen Member; Jeanne Holmes, Citizen Member; Jane R. Ingalls, R.N., C.N.S., Ph.D; Florence Jones- Clarke, R.N., M.S.; Karen K. Schultz, M.B.A., Ph.D, Citizen Member; and William Traynham, L. P.N.

Others participating in the meeting were Howard M. Casway, Senior Assistant Attorney General; Wayne Halbleib, Senior Assistant Attorney General; Jay P. Douglas, R.N., M.S.M., C.S.A.C., Executive Director; Gloria D. Mitchell, R.N., M.S.N., M.B.A., Deputy Executive Director; Brenda Krohn, R.N., M.S. , Deputy Executive Director; Jodi P. Power, R.N., J.D. , Deputy Executive Director; Amy Davis, Executive Assistant; Anne Joseph, Deputy Director, Administrative Proceedings Division; and Olivia Exterovic, Senior Adjudication Specialist.

The meeting was called to order by Dr. Selig. With nine members of the Board participating, a quorum was established. A poll of those participating showed that a good faith effort to convene a regular meeting within the week was not possible.

Wayne Halbeib, Senior Assistant Attorney General, presented evidence that the continued massage therapy practice of Jeffrey Thompson, C.M.T. 0019-003365 may present a substantial danger to the health and safety of the public.

Mr. Traynham moved to summarily suspend the right to renew the massage therapy certificate of Jeffrey Thompson pending a formal administrative hearing and to offer a consent order for revocation of the right to renew his certificate in lieu of a formal hearing. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

Wayne Halbeib, Senior Assistant Attorney General, presented evidence that the continued massage therapy practice of Wade Gustafson, C.M.T. 0019-007500 may present a substantial danger to the health and safety of the public.

Ms. Hartz moved to summarily suspend the massage therapy certificate of Wade Gustafson pending a formal administrative hearing and to offer a consent order for revocation of his certificate in lieu of a formal hearing. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:13 A.M.
