CALL TO ORDER: A meeting of a Special Conference Committee of the Board of Pharmacy was called to order at 9:30 a.m.

Tiawanda L. Deyo appeared to discuss allegations that she may have violated certain laws and regulations governing the practice of pharmacy technicians as stated in the June 27, 2011, Notice.

Closed Meeting: Upon a motion by Ms. Stelly, and duly seconded by Mr. Yi, the Committee unanimously voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to § 2.2-3711.A(28) of the Code of Virginia, for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Tiawanda L. Deyo. Additionally, he moved that Cathy Reiniers-Day and Mykl Egan attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.

Reconvene: Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed meeting met the requirements of § 2.2-3712 of the Code, the Committee re-convened in open meeting and announced the decision.

Decision: Upon a motion by Ms. Stelly, and duly seconded by Mr. Yi, the Committee closed this case as undetermined.

Gaynell H. Smith-Gray appeared to discuss allegations that she may have violated certain laws and regulations governing the practice of pharmacy as stated in the June 27, 2011, Notice.

- Closed Meeting: Upon a motion by Ms. Pratt, and duly seconded by Mr. Yi, the Committee unanimously voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to § 2.2-3711.A(28) of the Code of Virginia, for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Gaynell Smith-Gray. Additionally, he moved that Cathy Reiniers-Day and Mykl Egan attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.
- Reconvene: Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed meeting met the requirements of § 2.2-3712 of the Code, the Committee re-convened in open meeting and announced the decision.
- Decision: Upon a motion by Ms. Stelly, and duly seconded by Mr. Yi, the Committee made certain Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law and unanimously voted to issue an Order that requires Ms. Smith-Gray to successfully complete four (4) additional hours of continuing pharmacy education in the subject of medication errors.
- As provided by law, this decision shall become a final Order thirty (30) days after service of such Order on Ms. Smith-Gray, unless a written request is made to the Board requesting a formal hearing on the allegations made against her is received from Ms. Smith-Gray within such time. If service of the Order is made by mail, three (3) additional days shall be added to that period. Upon such timely request for a formal hearing, the decision of this Special Conference Committee shall be vacated.

- Nathaniel T. Ballou did not appear at the special conference. The Committee chose to proceed in his absence as the notice was mailed to Mr. Ballou's legal address of record and returned. The committee discussed that he may have violated certain laws and regulations governing the practice of pharmacy as stated in the June 27, 2011, Notice.
- Closed Meeting: Upon a motion by Ms. Pratt, and duly seconded by Mr. Yi, the Committee unanimously voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to § 2.2-3711.A(28) of the Code of Virginia, for the purpose of deliberation to reach a

decision in the matter of Nathaniel T. Ballou. Additionally, he moved that Cathy Reiniers-Day and Mykl Egan attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.

Reconvene: Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed meeting met the requirements of § 2.2-3712 of the Code, the Committee re-convened in open meeting and announced the decision.

Decision: Upon a motion by Ms. Stelly, and duly seconded by Mr. Yi, the Committee made certain Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law and unanimously voted to issue Mr. Ballou a reprimand and impose a monetary penalty of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000).

As provided by law, this decision shall become a final Order thirty (30) days after service of such Order on Mr. Ballou, unless a written request is made to the Board requesting a formal hearing on the allegations made against him is received from Mr. Ballou within such time. If service of the Order is made by mail, three (3) additional days shall be added to that period. Upon such timely request for a formal hearing, the decision of this Special Conference Committee shall be vacated.
