MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 PM.

Derral Jones, Department of Conservation and Recreation, Planning Bureau Manager, welcomed the committee and invited questions, comments and concerns regarding the master planning process. Derral reviewed a County topographical map with the committee, focusing on the slopes and geographical features of the park.

Beth Locklear, Locality Liaison, with the Department of Conservation and Recreation Division of Natural Heritage, then reviewed the identified rare, threatened and endangered species in the park.

Committee members introduced themselves and the organization they represented.

Bill Conkle, Park Planner, then facilitated the discussion of the identified 6 goals and related objectives in the areas of natural resources; cultural resources; environmental education; outdoor recreation and water access; community partnerships; and park management. The group then adopted a draft purpose statement for the park.

Derral Jones, Park Planner, then thanked everyone for their participation in the meeting and reviewed the date, time and location for the first public meeting, which will be on Monday July 28, 2003, 7:00 p.m. at the Ferlazzo Building Auditorium, 15941 Donald Curtis Drive, Woodbridge, Virginia.
