

SECOND PUBLIC MEETING ON THE MASTER PLAN FOR
LEESYLVANIA STATE PARK

MONDAY OCTOBER 6, 2003
LEESYLVANIA STATE PARK VISITOR'S CENTER

The meeting was called to order at 7:15 p.m.

James Klakwicz, State Park Manager, welcomed the public to the meeting.

Derral Jones, Park Planner, reviewed the master planning process and emphasized that the purpose of the public meeting was to allow the public an opportunity to respond to the proposed developments at the park.

Bill Conkle, Park Planner, then invited the public to present comments. Approximately 20 people were in attendance. One speaker presented comments at the meeting. The speaker stated that the ramps and piers recently destroyed by Hurricane Isabel were an economic stimulus for the area. The speaker requested that the ramps and piers be repaired and opened as soon as possible to limit the hardship on local businesses that are dependent upon the launch facilities for their livelihood. Attendees were informed that written comments regarding proposed developments at the park were welcome .
