Ms. Becker, finding a quorum of the Board present, called the <u>Call to Order</u> meeting to order at 9:02 a.m.

Ms. Henshaw advised the Board of the emergency evacuation procedures.

Emergency Evacuation Procedures

Mr. Magruder moved to approve the agenda as presented. Mr. Approval of Agenda Koepf seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by:
Baynes, Fincher, Fritz, Haltigan, Koepf, Magruder, Marston, Molter, and Palmer. Board members Becker and Nash were present but did not vote because, by statute, they are ineligible to vote on matters unrelated to renovation, repair, and painting (RRP) until the effective date of the regulations.

Mr. Marston moved to approve the minutes of the November 15, Approval of 2016, Board meeting as presented. Mr. Magruder seconded the Minutes

motion which was unanimously approved by: Baynes, Fincher, Fritz, Haltigan, Koepf, Magruder, Marston, Molter, and Palmer. Board members Becker and Nash were present but did not vote because, by statute, they are ineligible to vote on matters unrelated to renovation, repair, and painting (RRP) until the effective date of the regulations.

Ms. Henshaw introduced to the Board new staff members Joe Introduction of Staff Haughwout, Board and Regulatory Administrator, and Lisa Robinson, Licensing Operations Administrator.

Public Comment Period

Ms. Becker and Mr. Molter recused themselves from the meeting for the discussions and deliberations regarding File Number 2016-01000. Mr. Palmer, Vice-Chair, assumed the chair of the Board.

Recusal of Board Members

In the matter of File Number 2016-01000, Princeton Industrial Training Institute, the Board members reviewed the record which consisted of the Notice of Prima Facie Case, Report of Findings, evidence. and the Presiding Officer's Summary and Mr. Magruder moved to accept the Recommendation. recommendation of the Presiding Officer and find Princeton Industrial Training Institute in violation of the following Board regulations:

Ms. Baynes seconded the motion which was approved by: Baynes, Fincher, Fritz, Haltigan, Koepf, Magruder, Marston, and Palmer. Board member Nash was present but did not vote because, by statute, he is ineligible to vote on matters unrelated to renovation, repair, and painting (RRP) until the effective date of the regulations.

Mr. Magruder then moved to accept the recommendation as to the sanctions and impose monetary penalties totaling \$600.00, and withdraw Princeton Industrial Training Institute's Board approval as an accredited training provider. Mr. Fritz seconded the motion which was approved by: Baynes, Fincher, Fritz, Haltigan, Koepf, Magruder, Marston, and Palmer. Board member Nash was present but did not vote because, by statute, he is ineligible to vote on matters unrelated to renovation, repair, and painting (RRP) until the

effective date of the regulations.

Ms. Becker and Mr. Molter returned to the meeting.

In the matter of File Number 2017-01158, Wilson J. Nunez, the Board members reviewed the application file, which consisted of the exhibits and the Presiding Officer's summary and recommendation. Mr. Marston moved to accept the summary and recommendation of the Presiding Officer and deny Mr. Nunez's application for an asbestos worker license. Mr. Magruder seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by: Baynes, Fincher, Fritz, Haltigan, Koepf, Magruder, Marston, Molter, and Palmer. Board members Becker and Nash were present but did not vote because, by statute, they are ineligible to vote on matters unrelated to renovation, repair, and painting (RRP) until the effective date of the regulations.

In the matter of File Number 2017-01196, Jeovanie G. Ventura-Paxtor, the Board members reviewed the application file, which consisted of the exhibits and the Presiding Officer's summary and recommendation. Mr. Marston moved to accept the summary and recommendation of the Presiding Officer and deny Mr. Ventura-Paxtor's application for an asbestos supervisor license. Mr. Fincher seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by: Baynes, Fincher, Fritz, Haltigan, Koepf, Magruder, Marston,

The public comment period on the Home Inspector Licensing Implementation regulations ended on January 15, 2017. Haughwout advised the Board that public comments received would be presented to the Board during its consideration of adoption of final regulation text later in the meeting.

The public comment period on the Home Inspector Training Program provisions also ended on January 15, 2017. Haughwout advised the Board that public comments received would be presented to the Board during its consideration of adoption of final regulation text later in the meeting.

Update on Regulatory Review Processes

The regulation update for asbestos analytical laboratories and project monitors is currently in the proposed stage. After Board adoption of the proposed regulation text, the proposed text will be submitted for executive branch review.

The public comment period on the fast track action to amend public participation guidelines ended on December 28, 2016. No public comments were received. The amended regulations became effective January 12, 2017.

The proposed Lead-Based Paint Renovation, Repair, and Painting Program Regulations (Initial Promulgation) are currently undergoing review by the Governor's office. If approved, the regulations will be posted to the Virginia Register and a 60-day public comment period will commence, to include a public hearing.

Mr. Haughwout presented the Board with public comments received on the draft text of the Home Inspector Licensing and Training Program regulations, as well as a draft of Board responses Home Inspector to the public comments received.

Mr. Haughwout advised the Board of amendments to the draft text Program of the Home Inspector Licensing and Training Program regulations Regulations made by staff after consideration of the public comments received. Discussion was held on the following topics:

- Reciprocity and agreements with neighboring states,
- Reporting requirements regarding yellow corrugated stainless steel tubing (CSST)
- Home Inspectors citing building code, and
- License status during the reinstatement period.

Mr. Leedom addressed the Board regarding DPOR's process for handling complaints received for unlicensed activity during the Mr. Leedom advised the Board that reinstatement period. complaint analysis staff is currently working with DPOR investigators to devise a policy conforming to Virginia statutes for bringing licensees into compliance in instances wherein a license has expired but the license holder continues to perform work requiring a current, valid license.

The Board recessed from 10:20 a.m. to 10:28 a.m.

After discussion, Mr. Molter moved to adopt responses to the Consider Public public comments as presented by staff. Mr. Marston seconded the Comments on motion which was unanimously approved by: Baynes, Fincher, Home Inspector

Consider Public Comments on Licensing and Training

Licensing and Training Program

Ms. Henshaw asked the Board to consider whether the training course required to obtain the NRS specialty could be counted toward continuing education credit as required to maintain licensure. The Board agreed by consensus that NRS specialty training will count toward CPE credits.

Consider Adoption of Final Home Inspector Licensing and Training Program Regulations

Ms. Henshaw asked the Board to consider a provision requiring all current certified home inspectors whose certifications expire on June 30, 2017, to meet all new license renewal criteria effective July 1, 2017, if the licensees' renewals are not received prior to July 1, 2017. The Board agreed by consensus to require all renewing certified home inspectors to meet the new criteria if their renewals are not received prior to July 1, 2017.

Mr. Fritz moved to adopt the final text of the Home Inspector Licensing regulations, and the Training Program regulations, to include the discussed NRS provision, as presented by staff and amended by the Board. Mr. Koepf seconded the motion which was Baynes, Fincher, Fritz, Haltigan, unanimously approved by: Koepf, Magruder, Marston, Molter, and Palmer. Board members Becker and Nash were present but did not vote because, by statute, they are ineligible to vote on matters unrelated to renovation, repair, and painting (RRP) until the effective date of the regulations.

Mr. Haughwout presented the Board with staff suggested changes to the proposed text of the Laboratory Licensing and Project Monitor Reporting regulatory amendments originally reviewed by the Board on November 15, 2016. After review and discussion of the proposed changes, Mr. Magruder moved to adopt the proposed text of the Laboratory Licensing and Project Monitor Reporting regulations, including amendments made by staff, and to allow staff to file for executive branch review. Mr. Magruder further moved to authorize staff to make necessary minor amendments, in consultation with the Chair, as may be needed during the review Mr. Marston seconded the motion which was process. Baynes, Fincher, Fritz, Haltigan, unanimously approved by: Koepf, Magruder, Marston, Molter, and Palmer. Board members Becker and Nash were present but did not vote because, by statute,
