Chairperson Mentz, finding a quorum of the Board present, called Call to Order the meeting to order at 9:05 AM.

Mr. Crockett moved that the Board approve the agenda as prepared by staff. Mr. Heppner seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously by seven aye votes (Messrs. Crockett, Geller, Bouldin, Heppner, and Honeycutt; and Mses. Mentz and Harlow) The agenda is attached.

Adopt Agenda

Mr. Heppner moved that the Board approve the minutes of its June 4, 2003 meeting, the July 16, 2003 IFF, and the July 23, 2003 IFF collectively as prepared by staff. Mr. Geller seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously by seven aye votes (Messrs. Crockett, Geller, Bouldin, Heppner, and Honeycutt; and Mses. Mentz and Harlow).

(Respondent) was not present. Upon a motion by Mr. Heppner and seconded by Mr. Crockett, the Board adopted the summary and recommendation, and approved the application for Asbestos Worker license for Patricia Carolina Amaya-Vasquez. motion carried. Members voting "YES" were Messrs. Crockett, Bouldin, Heppner, and Honeycutt; and Ms. Mentz. Members voting "NO" were Ms. Harlow. The presiding Board member, Mr. Geller, left the room and did not participate in the discussion or vote.

Upon a motion by Mr. Crockett and seconded by Mr. Bouldin, the Board adopted the summary and recommendation, and approved the application for Asbestos Worker license for Tavaras Jermaine Williams. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "YES" were Messrs. Crockett, Bouldin, Heppner, and Honeycutt; and Mses. Mentz and Harlow. The presiding Board member, Mr. Geller, left the room and did not participate in the discussion or vote

Arrival of Board Member

In the matter of File Number 2002-02925, Board v. Keystone File Number Environmental Services, the Board reviewed the Consent Order 2002-02925

Number 2004-0042, which was offered to and signed by Keystone Environmental Services (Respondent). Upon a motion by Mr. Crockett and seconded by Ms. Harlow, the Board accepted the consent order to have Keystone Environmental Services voluntarily surrender their Lead Contractor License, pay a monetary penalty of \$2,500, and not reapply for licensure for a period of one year. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "YES" were Messrs. Crockett, Bouldin, Heppner, Nott, and Geller; and Mses. Mentz and Harlow. The presiding Board member, Mr. Honeycutt, left the room and did not participate in the discussion or vote.

In the matter of File Number 2002-02927, Board v. Keystone Environmental Services, the Board reviewed the Consent Order Number 2004-0041, which was offered to and signed by Keystone Environmental Services (Respondent). Upon a motion by Mr. Heppner and seconded by Mr. Nott, the Board accepted the consent order to have Keystone Environmental Services voluntarily surrender their Asbestos Contractor License, pay a monetary penalty of \$2,500, and not reapply for licensure for a period of one year. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "YES" were Messrs. Crockett, Bouldin, Heppner, Nott, and Geller; and Mses. Mentz and Harlow. The presiding Board member, Mr. Honeycutt, left the room and did not participate in the discussion or vote.

File Number 2002-02927

In the matter of File Number 2003-00601, Board v. J&W Sandblasting and File Number 2003-00602, Board v. Elbert Lee Davis, the Board reviewed the record, which consisted of the application file, transcript and exhibits from the IFF, and the presiding Board member's summary and recommendation. Paul Murphy addressed the Board on behalf of J&W Sandblasting and Mr. Elbert Davis. Upon a motion by Mr. Crockett and seconded the Board rejected the summary and by Mr. Nott, recommendation of the presiding Board member and closed the files with a finding of no violation. The motion carried. Members voting "YES" were Messrs. Crockett, Heppner, Nott, and Geller; and Ms. Mentz. Members voting "NO" were Mr. Bouldin and Ms. Harlow. The presiding Board member, Mr. Honeycutt, left the room and did not participate in the discussion or vote.

File Number 2003-00601 & File Number 2003-00602

James Guffey addressed the Board concerning the current process Other Business used when offering consent orders to approved Asbestos Training Programs who have not complied with the requirements of the Board's regulations to submit notifications at least 48 hours in advance of the date a training program is to be offered and to submit participation lists within 24 hours after the completion of a training program. Upon a motion by Mr. Crockett and seconded by Ms. Harlow, the Board accepted Mr. Guffey's proposal to current Asbestos Training Program administratively and send a letter to each reminding them of the The motion passed unanimously. current requirements. Members voting "YES" were Messrs. Crockett, Bouldin, Heppner, Nott, and Honeycutt, and Geller; and Mses. Mentz and Harlow.

Karen O'Neal recommended that the Board permit DPOR's new staff attorney and former Board members to serve as the presiding officers during IFF's. DPOR staff would be appropriate in cases where no industry expertise is required and former Board members would be appropriate where industry expertise is needed. Upon a motion by Mr. Bouldin and seconded by Mr. Heppner, the Board accepted Ms. O'Neal's recommendation. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "YES" were Messrs. Crockett, Bouldin, Heppner, Nott, and Honeycutt, and Geller; and Mses. Mentz and Harlow.

Mr. Heppner expressed the Home Inspector Industry's concern with requiring client information on both the home inspection contracts and reports. No action was taken.

Mr. Perry informed the Board that the current examination Lead Examination contract with Experior expires December 31, 2003 and that Update Professional Credential Services, Inc. (PCS) is under contract to develop a new Lead Examination for implementation on January 1, 2004. PCS will administer the exam daily by computer at 11 examination sites throughout the state. PCS currently administers several examinations for DPOR and has developed Lead Examinations in other states.

Mr. Perry informed the Board that the final Lead-Based Paint Update on Final Regulations were approved by the Governor on July 7, 2003, Lead-Based Paint published in the Virginia Register on August 11, 2003, and will Regulations

be effective October 1, 2003.

The Board reviewed the amendments to the Board's Public PPG Regulations-Participation Guidelines prepared by staff.

Fast Track

Upon a motion by Mr. Crockett and seconded by Mr. Heppner, the Board adopted the amendments to the Board's Public and Guidelines Regulations Participation promulgation under the fast track provisions of the Virginia Administrative Process Act (APA). The motion was carried unanimously Members voting "YES" were Messrs. Crockett, Bouldin, Heppner, Nott, Honeycutt, and Geller, and Mses. Mentz and Harlow.

Mr. Perry presented his report to the Board on the National EPA National EPA Lead Lead Conference held in San Antonio, TX on June 9-11, 2003. Conference Report He indicated that EPA presented two different proposals for Renovation and Remodeling Regulations. One proposal incorporated renovation and remodeling into the existing 402 regulations. The second proposal was a voluntary alternative. Mr. Perry also discussed the proposed Bridges and Steel EPA also indicated that additional Structures Regulations. regulation may not be needed, and that current regulations by OSHA, RCRA, and the Clean Water Act may be sufficient At this time, EPA is unsure as to which direction they may take with either set of regulations.

Mr. Perry indicated that there are agreements in place between State Attorneys General and the National Paint and Coatings Association (NPCA) for the Paint Manufacturing Industry to provide training on lead safe work practices to Contractors and to provide label and sticker warnings on paint and coatings that informs consumers that sanding, scraping, or removal of old paint may release lead dust.

Ms. Mentz opened the floor for nominations for Chairperson and Election of Officers Vice Chairperson.

Mr. Crockett nominated Ms. Mentz for Chairperson. Mr. Bouldin nominated Mr. Geller for Vice Chairperson. Hearing no further nominations for Chairperson or Vice Chairperson, Ms. Mentz closed the nominations.

Ms. Mentz called for a vote on the nominees for Chairperson and Vice Chairperson. The Board unanimously elected Ms. Mentz as Chairperson and Mr. Geller as Vice Chairperson by eight aye votes (Messrs. Crockett, Bouldin, Heppner, Nott, Honeycutt, and Geller; and Mses. Mentz and Harlow).
