Adopt Agenda

Upon a motion by Mr. Heppner and seconded by Mr. Crockett, the Board adopted the summaries, as amended, and the conclusions that Mr. Guest violated § 18 VAC 15-20-450(A)(6) of the Board's 2002 Regulations with regard to File Numbers 2004-01596 and 2004-01598, and violated § 18 VAC 15-30-810(A)(6) of the Board's 1995 Regulations with regard to File Number 2004-01606. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "YES" were Messrs. Crockett, Geller, Heppner, and Bouldin; and Mses. Lowman and Harlow. The presiding Board member, Ms. Mentz, was unable to attend the meeting and, therefore, did not participate in the discussion or vote.

Mr. Heppner moved that the Board reject the recommendations of the presiding Board member that the Board levy a monetary penalty of \$500 for each violation found in File Numbers 2004-01596, 2004-01598, and 2004-01606. Mr. Bouldin seconded the motion which carried unanimously. Members voting "YES" were Messrs. Crockett, Geller, Heppner, and Bouldin; and Mses. Lowman and Harlow. The presiding Board member, Ms. Mentz, was unable to attend the meeting and, therefore, did not participate in the discussion or vote.

Mr. Crockett moved that the Board revoke Mr. Guest's Asbestos Inspector License (3303-001534), Asbestos Project Monitor License (3309-000466), and his Lead Risk Assessor License

(3356-000066) based upon the magnitude of the federal case and conviction, and the severity of the violation of the Board's regulations. Mr. Heppner seconded the motion which carried unanimously. Members voting "YES" were Messrs. Crockett, Geller, Heppner, and Bouldin; and Mses. Lowman and Harlow. The presiding Board member, Ms. Mentz, was unable to attend the meeting and, therefore, did not participate in the discussion or vote.

In the matter of <u>File Number 2004-01595</u>, Board v. ETMS, Inc., the Board reviewed the record, which consisted of the investigative file, transcript and exhibits from the IFF, and the presiding Board member's summary, conclusion and recommendation. Glen Huff (Attorney for Respondent) addressed the Board.

File Number 2004-01595

Earlyne Perkins shared with the Board that the minutes need to reflect a typographical error in the Summation of Facts #1 as follows: The first sentence of paragraph one is deleted and replaced with "On January 5, 2004, in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Virginia, Alexandria Division, ETMS, Inc. was convicted on two counts of False Statements, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1001 and 2, both felonies." The last sentence of paragraph one was also deleted.

Upon a motion by Mr. Heppner and seconded by Mr. Crockett, the Board adopted the summary, as amended, and the conclusion that ETMS, Inc. violated § 18 VAC 15-20-450(A)(6) of the Board's 2002 Regulations. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "YES" were Messrs. Crockett, Geller, Heppner, and Bouldin; and Mses. Lowman and Harlow. The presiding Board member, Ms. Mentz, was unable to attend the meeting and, therefore, did not participate in the discussion or vote.

Mr. Heppner moved that the Board reject the recommendation of the presiding Board member that the Board levy a monetary penalty of \$1,000. Mr. Bouldin seconded the motion which carried unanimously. Members voting "YES" were Messrs. Crockett, Geller, Heppner, and Bouldin; and Mses. Lowman and Harlow. The presiding Board member, Ms. Mentz, was unable to attend the meeting and, therefore, did not participate in the discussion or vote.

Mr. Crockett moved that the Board revoke ETMS Inc.'s Asbestos Analytical Laboratory License (3333-000154) based upon the magnitude of the federal case and conviction, and the severity of

the violation of the Board's regulations. Mr. Heppner seconded the motion which carried unanimously. Members voting "YES" were Messrs. Crockett, Geller, Heppner, and Bouldin; and Mses. Lowman and Harlow. The presiding Board member, Ms. Mentz, was unable to attend the meeting and, therefore, did not participate in the discussion or vote.

In the matter of File Number 2004-02155, Board v. Elvin Ventura, the Board reviewed the record, which consisted of the application file, transcript and exhibits from the IFF, and the presiding officer's summary, conclusion and recommendation. Elvin Ventura (Respondent) was not present. Upon a motion by Mr. Crockett and seconded by Ms. Harlow, the Board adopted the summary and recommendation, and approved the application for Asbestos Worker license for Elvin Ventura. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "YES" were Messrs. Crockett, Geller, Heppner, and Bouldin; and Mses. Lowman and Harlow.

File Number 2004-02155

David Dick updated the Board on the status of HB 462 (Summary Legislative and Suspension of Licenses) and HB 463 (Necessity of Licensure). Both bills were passed by the House of Delegates and were scheduled to be reviewed by the Senate Committee on General Laws when it meets on the afternoon of February 18, 2004. Passage by the Senate is expected.

Regulatory Action

Ms. Harlow moved that the Board adopt a Notice of Intended Regulatory Action (NOIRA) to review current requirements for Asbestos Project Monitors and adopting ostensible ownership language. Mr. Crockett seconded the motion which carried unanimously. Members voting "YES" were Messrs. Crockett, Geller, Heppner, and Bouldin; and Mses. Lowman and Harlow.

Ms. Lowman moved that the Board accept the proposed letter Other Business drafted by staff to be sent to Training Providers concerning English-Only accredited training programs. Mr. Crockett seconded the motion which carried unanimously. Members voting "YES" were Messrs. Crockett, Geller, Heppner, and Bouldin; and Mses. Lowman and Harlow.
