

## Equality and Equity and Justice



Status Quo: The three stick figures are identical. Through no fault of their own, they are on different elevations. Each want to see the view, but the view is blocked by the fence. Only one of the three can see the view because it is on higher ground.

Equality: In order to meet the goal of all seeing the view, the same resources are given to all three stick figures. Under this scenario, not all three can see the view. In this case, the higher one can see very well, but the lower one still cannot enjoy the view.

Equity: To meet the goal that all will see the view, resources are provided to meet the needs of the individual stick figure. Now all can see the view.

Justice: The fence is removed. Now all can see the view from where they are positioned without additional resources.
