#### VIRGINIA BOARD FOR WATERWORKS AND WASTEWATER WORKS OPERATORS AND ONSITE SEWAGE SYSTEM PROFESSIONALS

#### MINUTES OF MEETING

The Virginia Board for Waterworks and Wastewater Works Operators and Onsite Sewage System Professionals met on January 10, 2013, at the offices of the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation (DPOR), Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Board Room 3, Richmond, Virginia 23233.

Finding a quorum of the Board present, Mr. Philpy, Chair, called Call to Order the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m.

Ms. Henshaw advised the Board of the emergency evacuation Emergency procedures. Evacuation **Procedures** 

Mr. F. Davis moved to approve the agenda with an amendment to Approval of correct the presiding officers for items 13 and 14 to reflect that staff Agenda Mr. K. Davis seconded the motion which was presided. unanimously approved by: Aulbach, F. Davis, K. Davis, Dunkley, Greene, Lentz, Magrino, Philpy, Schafran, Staples, and Thomas.

Mr. K. Davis moved that the Board approve the minutes of the Approval of following meetings:

Mr. Staples seconded the motion which was unanimously approved Aulbach, F. Davis, K. Davis, Dunkley, Greene, Lentz, Magrino, Philpy, Schafran, Staples, and Thomas.

Mr. Philpy opened the floor for public comment. Mr. Jeff Walker, a certified professional soil scientist, onsite soil evaluator and an interim alternative onsite sewage system installer, addressed the Board during the Public Comment Period. Mr. Walker expressed his concern about the difference in work product requirements of private onsite soil evaluators versus Virginia Department of Health (VDH) employees. Mr. Walker requested the Board, along with the boards that regulate soil scientists and professional engineers, discuss the responsibility, ethics, accountability, and standards in the industry to ensure that the public safety and welfare of citizens are being protected.

**Public Comment** Period

At the October 3, 2012 Board meeting, members of the Board requested that Ms. Henshaw research issues that have arisen pertaining to onsite sewage system operators. In consideration of the variety of concerns presented and the number of professional areas that may be affected, Ms. Henshaw, in coordination with the Board Chair, proposed forming a committee of stakeholders to identify issues and concerns that have been raised by onsite sewage system professionals regarding specific requirements affecting their practice, and to recommend possible solutions to address such issues and concerns.

Consideration of **Onsite Sewage** System **Professionals** Workgroup

Mr. Dixon suggested that the committee should include a consumer representative familiar with the process of having an onsite sewage system designed and installed.

After discussion, Mr. Dunkley made a motion to have the Board form the Onsite Sewage System Professionals Workgroup charged with identifying issues and concerns that have been raised by onsite sewage system professionals regarding specific requirements affecting their practice, and recommending possible solutions to address such issues and concerns. Mr. Staples seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by: Aulbach, F. Davis, K. Davis, Dunkley, Greene, Lentz, Magrino, Philpy, Schafran, Staples.

and Thomas.

After discussion, Mr. Staples made a motion to direct staff to extend an invitation to the following members to serve on the Workgroup: Mr. Philpy to serve as Chair of the Onsite Sewage System Professionals Workgroup; Mr. Aulbach, Mr. K. Davis, and Mr. Thomas were selected to serve as Board member representatives; staff members from the Virginia Department of Health (VDH); Wayne Gentry, industry representative; Mike Lynn, The SES Companies; Bob Marshall, Cloverleaf Environmental Consultant, Inc.; Curtis Moore, industry representative; a manufacturer representative; a professional engineer representative from the Board for Architects, Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, Certified Interior Designers, and Landscape Architects; and authorize Ms. Henshaw, in consultation with the Chair, to select an additional consumer member to serve on the Workgroup. Mr. Dunkley seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by: Aulbach, F. Davis, K. Davis, Dunkley, Greene, Lentz, Magrino, Philpy, Schafran, Staples, and Thomas. Once a date has been set, the Workgroup will be notified.

Ms. Henshaw gave an update on the current status of the regulatory Update on review process for the Waterworks and Wastewater Works Regulatory Activity Operators and Onsite Sewage System Professionals Regulations. The fast-track regulatory action amending the definitions related to supervision and entry requirements for installers has completed the executive branch review. During the public comment period, sufficient objections were received to stop the fast-track process. The action was resubmitted using the standard process and is undergoing executive branch review.

Ms. Henshaw discussed the Governor's Regulatory Reform Initiative to conduct a comprehensive review of all DPOR Governor's regulations currently in place and repeal regulations that are unnecessary or no longer in use, reduce unnecessary regulatory Initiative burdens on individuals, businesses, and other regulated groups, and identify statutes that require unnecessary or overly burdensome regulations.

Discussion of Regulatory Reform

A public comment period was held from November to early December to receive comments on regulations that could be or amended to reduce regulatory burdens. eliminated Simultaneously, staff conducted a review of the regulations to identify areas that can be reduced or eliminated. No public comments were received.

Ms. Henshaw advised the Board that staff conducted a review of Consider

the regulations and recommends that the Board amend documentation required to qualify for the conventional onsite sewage system installers exam waiver by eliminating the need to provide documentation by specific professionals as required by 18 VAC 160-20-97.C.2.a. The Board discussed the provisions of 18 VAC 160-20-97 of the Waterworks and Wastewater Works Operators and Onsite Sewage System Professionals Regulations concerning qualifications for licensure for onsite sewage system Ms. Henshaw advised that a Notice of Intended installers. Regulatory Action (NOIRA) for the Waterworks and Wastewater Works Operators and Onsite Sewage System Professionals Regulations must be authorized by the Board if it wishes to initiate the regulatory review process pursuant to the Governor's Regulatory Reform Initiative. A motion was made by Mr. F. Davis to authorize staff to file a Notice of Intended Regulatory Action for the Board for Waterworks and Wastewater Works Operators and Onsite Sewage System Professionals Regulations to proceed with the amendment of onsite sewage system installer requirements as well as any other amendments that may be identified that achieve the objectives of the Governor's Regulatory Reform Initiative. Mr. Dunkley seconded the motion which was unanimously approved Aulbach, F. Davis, K. Davis, Dunkley, Greene, Lentz, Magrino, Philpy, Schafran, Staples, and Thomas.

#### Authorization of **NOIRA**

Ms. Henshaw provided an overview of the upcoming legislation Legislative Update that has been proposed to date for consideration during the 2013 Virginia General Assembly session as it pertains to the Board's programs. Ms. Henshaw explained that all Board and industryrelated legislation is monitored by the Board and Department staff. While staff may provide technical information, data, and statistics regarding legislative proposals, Ms. Henshaw reminded the Board members that neither staff nor the Board has a position on a particular bill until such time as the Governor issues a position. Currently, staff is following House Bill 1482 and monitoring House Bill 1611 and House Bill 1726.

Ms. Atkinson provided an updated Memorandum of the Update on CPE Wastewater Works Operators 2012 Continuing Professional Audit As of November 2012, the regulant Education (CPE) audit. population for wastewater works operators totaled 2,374. Based on previous guidance from the Board, five percent of those regulants were randomly selected for audit, which equals 118 regulants selected. Individuals licensed less than two years as of February 29, 2012, were manually excluded. As of January 9, 2013, a total of 68 audits have been received, 55 passed, 12 were incomplete, and one extension was requested. Staff will be sending a follow-up letter on February 4, 2013, with a deadline of March 6, 2013, to all

regulants who have failed to respond or provided insufficient documentation. Ms. Atkinson will provide an update on the CPE audit at the next Board meeting.

Ms. Atkinson provided an update on the process developed in coordination with the Department of Corrections (DOC) for an Department of alternative informal fact-finding conference (IFF) application process for Class 4 wastewater works operator apprentices. At the January 11, 2012, Board meeting, Mr. Dick advised the Board of Executive Order #11 (2010) which created the Virginia Prisoner Application Process and Juvenile Offender Re-entry Council, and the DOC's request for DPOR to assist with its Class 4 wastewater works operator apprenticeship program by providing informal fact-finding conferences prior to apprentices being eligible to sit for the Class 4 wastewater works operator apprentice exam, preferably within the first three months of their enrollment in the apprenticeship program.

Update on **Corrections** Informal Fact-**Finding** 

Current licensure procedures require wastewater works operator applicants for licensure to submit an application and \$94 fee to PSI to take an exam, and after passing the exam, to submit an application and \$100 fee for licensure to DPOR, at which time criminal convictions are reviewed and a determination is made whether an IFF is required. Through collaboration with DOC and the Department's Information Systems (IS), Information Management (IM), and Exams Sections, and PSI, the exam vendor, the application process for DOC apprentice applicants has been revised. For each apprentice applicant, DOC will submit an application and \$100 fee to DPOR, the Board Administrative Proceeding Section (BAPS) will hold an IFF and render a recommendation, and the Board will determine the apprentice applicant's eligibility to sit for the exam. After an apprentice gains required experience, DOC will submit an exam application and \$94 fee to PSI. If no further criminal convictions are reported, the apprentice applicant remains eligible to take the exam. After passing the exam, the apprentice will be issued a Class 4 wastewater works operator license. Applicants have two years from Board approval to take and pass the examination.

There are currently 14 pending DOC applications.
