


**COMMITTEE OF THE JOINT BOARDS OF NURSING AND

- TIME AND PLACE:** The meeting of the Special Conference Committee of the Committee of the Joint Boards of Nursing and Medicine was convened at 4:30 P.M., on February 22, 2022, in Board Room 4, Suite 201, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Henrico, Virginia.

- CLOSED MEETING:** Ms. Buchwald moved that the Special Conference Committee of the Committee of the Joint Boards of Nursing and Medicine convene a closed meeting pursuant to Section 2.2-3711(A)(16) of the *Code of Virginia* at 5:22 P.M. for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Ms. Gore. Additionally, Ms. Buchwald moved that Dr. Hills and Ms. Jones attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting is deemed necessary, and their presence will aid the Committee in its deliberations. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.
- RECONVENTION:** The Committee reconvened in open session at 5:47 P.M.
- Ms. Buchwald moved that the Special Conference of the Committee of the Joint Boards of Nursing and Medicine certify that it heard, discussed or considered only public business matters lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements under the Virginia Freedom of Information Act and only such public business matters as were identified in the motion by which the closed meeting was convened. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.
- ACTION:** Dr. Williams moved to issue an issue an Order to Approve the Application of Judith Gore for Reinstatement of her full prescriptive authority privileges contingent upon completion of a course on prescribing controlled substances and a summary of the NP prescriptive authority regulations. The basis of this decision will be set forth in an Order which will be mailed to Judith Gore at her address of record with the Committee. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

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An Order will be entered. As provided by law, this decision shall become a Final Order thirty days after service of such order on Judith Gore unless a written request to the Committee for a formal hearing on the allegations made against her is received from Ms. Gore within such time. If service of the order is made by mail, three additional days shall be added to that period. Upon such timely request for a formal hearing, the Order shall be vacated.
