meeting was convened. The motion was seconded and passed.

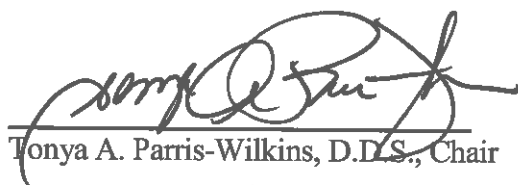
DECISION: Ms. Palmatier reported that the Committee dismissed the
