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- CALL TO ORDER:** A Special Conference Committee of the Board was called to order at 9:06 a.m.

- DISCUSSION:** Dr. Khan appeared before the Committee in person in accordance with a Notice of the Board dated March 6, 2017. Dr. Khan was not represented by counsel.
- The Committee fully discussed the allegation in the Notice and Dr. Khan's compliance with the Order entered October 5, 2016.
- CLOSED SESSION:** Upon a motion by Ms. Hickey, and duly seconded by Dr. Allison-Bryan, the Committee voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to §2.2-3711.A (27) of the Code of Virginia, for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Dr. Khan. Additionally, she moved that Ms. Deschenes and Ms. Wood attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.
- RECONVENE:** Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed session met the requirements of §2.2-3712 of the Code,

the Committee re-convened in open session and announced its decision.

**DECISION:**

Upon a motion by Ms. Hickey, and duly seconded by Dr. Allison-Bryan, the Committee made certain findings of fact and conclusions of law and voted to modify the prior Order to denial of reinstatement.

**VOTE:**

The vote was unanimous.

**ADJOURNMENT:**


The Committee adjourned at 10:52 a.m.
