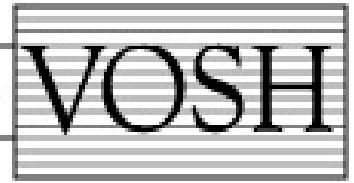

VOSH PROGRAM DIRECTIVE: 02-213

ISSUED: September 1, 1991

SUBJECT: Inspection Procedures and Guidelines for Lift-Slab Construction Operations

A. Purpose.

This directive establishes policies and provides clarification to ensure uniform enforcement of §1926.705, Lift-Slab Construction Operations.

B. Scope.

This directive applies VOSH-wide and specifically to Safety Enforcement Personnel.

C. Reference.

OSHA Instruction STD 3-15.3 (March 1, 1991)

D. Cancellation.

E. Action

The Assistant Commissioner, Directors and Supervisors shall assure that the policies and procedures explained in this directive are followed and that compliance officers are familiar with the contents of the standard.

The effective date of this directive is September 1, 1991.

H. **Background**

At the federal level, the standard for Lift-Slab Construction Operations was promulgated on October 18, 1990, at Federal Register Vol. 55, No. 202, Pgs. 42306-42330. In Virginia, the standard was promulgated on February 11, 1991 at Virginia Register Vol. 7, Issue 10 with an effective date of March 15, 1991.

This directive provides the compliance officer with inspection guidelines and citation policy in regard to certain requirements of the standard.
