Subject: Letter of Assurance for Amendments to Board for Contractors Regulations, 18 VAC 50-22-10 *et seq.*

I have reviewed the Board for Contractors' proposed amendments to its Licensing Regulations, 18 VAC 50-22-10 *et seq.*, particularly to 18 VAC 50-22-, which were posted on the Virginia Regulatory Town Hall internet site on March 31, 2014. In my view, as counsel to the Board for Contractors, these regulations may be promulgated pursuant to §§ 54.1-201 and 54.1-1102 of the *Code of Virginia*. The regulations do not appear to conflict with the Constitution of the United States or the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Virginia, nor do they appear to conflict with any federal or state law currently in effect.

This memorandum addresses legal matters only and is not intended to serve, nor should it be construed, as a comment for or against the merits of the proposed regulations.
