RE: Emergency Regulations 18 VAC 112-20-10 et seq. Regulations Governing the Practice of Physical Therapy

Dear Ms. Hahn:

I have reviewed the Emergency Regulations, as cited above, in accordance with the Administrative Process Act. The amended regulations to establish requirements for certification in direct access for physical therapists are constitutional and in conformity with existing statutory provisions of Chapters 9 and 18 of the 2007 Acts of the Assembly.

The "emergency situation" which exists is specified in § 2.2-4011 of the Code of Virginia as one in which the agency is required by statutory law to have a regulation in effect within 280 days from the enactment of the law. Having satisfied all legal requirements, you may proceed to take the necessary steps to promulgate this emergency regulation in accordance with the requirements of the Administrative Process Act.
