RE: 18 VAC 90-30-10 et seq. Regulations Governing the Practice of Nurse Practitioners

Dear Ms. Douglas:

I have reviewed the Emergency Regulation, 18VAC90-30-10 et seq., in accordance with the Administrative Process Act. The amended regulations for practice by nurse practitioners as part of a patient care team are constitutional and in conformity with statutory provisions of Chapter 213 of the 2012 Acts of the Assembly.

The "emergency situation" which exists is specified in §2.2-4011 of the Code of Virginia as one in which the agency is required by statutory law to have a regulation in effect within 280 days from the enactment of the Act. Having satisfied all legal requirements, you may proceed to take the necessary steps to promulgate this emergency regulation.
