Pursuant to [Ch. 62](#) and [Ch. 228](#) of the 2024 Acts of Assembly, the Board has amended 18VAC110-20-322 and 18VAC110-20-323 to remove drugs and chemicals placed in Virginia Code §§ 54.1-3446, 54.1-3448, 54.1-3452, and 54.1-3454 by the General Assembly.

[Ch. 62](#) and [Ch. 228](#) of the 2024 Acts of Assembly placed certain chemicals and drugs in Virginia Code §§ 54.1-3446, 54.1-3448, 54.1-3452, and 54.1-3454 which were previously scheduled in 18VAC110-20-322 and 18VAC110-20-323. Therefore, those chemicals and drugs no longer need to be included in the regulatory Schedules.
