



VOSH PROGRAM DIRECTIVE: 02-804

ISSUED: 01 August 2011

SUBJECT: **Subpart I, Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for Shipyard Employment (Public Sector)--Inspection Procedures and Interpretive Guidelines**

Purpose. This directive provides guidance concerning the application of current enforcement policy and procedures for PPE in shipyard employment (Public Sector) and ensures consistent enforcement of Part 1915, Subpart I, PPE, including PPE payment for shipyard employment activities.

This Program Directive is an internal guideline, not a statutory or regulatory rule, and is intended to provide instructions to VOSH personnel regarding internal operation of the Virginia Occupational Safety and Health Program and is solely for the benefit of the program. This document is not subject to the Virginia Register Act or the Administrative Process Act; it does not have general application and is not being enforced as having the force of law.

Scope. This directive applies to all VOSH personnel, and specifically to Occupational Safety Compliance and Consultation Services personnel. These Part 1915 standards apply to all work in public sector shipyard employment regardless of geographical location, but they do not apply to construction operations in shipyards covered by Part 1926.
