

**VOSH PROGRAM DIRECTIVE: 02-802A**

**ISSUED: 15 February 2014**

**SUBJECT:** Maritime Cargo Gear Standards and Part 1919 Certification

**Purpose** This directive transmits to field personnel guidance concerning OSHA's policy and procedures on the enforcement of gear certification standards in the maritime industry.

*This Program Directive is an internal guideline, not a statutory or regulatory rule, and is intended to provide instructions to VOSH personnel regarding internal operation of the Virginia Occupational Safety and Health Program and is solely for the benefit of the program. This document is not subject to the Virginia Register Act or the Administrative Process Act; it does not have general application and is not being enforced as having the force of law.*

**Scope** This directive applies to all VOSH personnel. *NOTE: VOSH's jurisdiction is limited to public sector maritime activity, if and when such public sector activity may occur.*

**Cancellation** VOSH PD 02-802 (March 1, 2005)

**Action** Directors and Managers shall ensure that the policies and procedures established in this Directive are uniform and are adhered to in administering the Maritime Cargo Gear Standards and Part 1919 Certification.
