The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m.

Call To Order

There was no public comment.

Public Comment

The Committee discussed Section 7.B.f of the draft State Apprenticeship Standards for Esthetics and Master Esthetics, related to credit for previous experience. By consensus, the Committee agreed to change the language of this section from "... the Industrial Cooperative Training Program ..." to "... a Virginia Department of Education approved program ..."

<u>Discussion –</u> <u>Standards of</u> Apprenticeship

The Committee reviewed the Virginia Code definitions of Esthetician, Master Esthetician, and Esthetics, as well as the Scope of Practice for Master Estheticians (18VAC41-70-250) as outlined in the Esthetics Regulations, in an effort to identify what products and practices could be utilized by basic Estheticians for chemical exfoliation.

Use of Chemical Exfoliants

The committee reviewed and discussed industry definitions of chemical exfoliation and reached consensus that chemical exfoliation involves the removal of dead skin cells and/or intercellular matrix through the use of chemicals. After discussion, the Committee's consensus was that a basic Esthetician cannot perform chemical exfoliation as the Code of Virginia 54.1-700. Definitions, delineates it as a procedure under the scope of a master esthetician.

The Committee discussed the practice of microneedling, which is not addressed in the Virginia Code or in the Esthetic Regulations. The Committee members agreed that the use of needles designed to pierce the

skin for the purpose of collagen production or cellular renewal is outside the scope of practice for Estheticians and Master Estheticians.
