Mr. Vanderland, acting as Chair, called the meeting to order at Call to Order 7:00 PM.

Mr. Alexander moved the adoption of the agenda prepared by Adopt Agenda staff, which was seconded by Mr. Crooks and carried by a unanimous aye vote.

Mr Dick briefed the Committee on the HB 3134 and SB 1270 HB 3134 and SB mandate to promulgate regulations governing Onsite Sewage System Professionals and have them in effect on July 1, 2009.

Mr. Dick briefed the Committee members on the role of the Role of Board Board in developing regulation provisions establishing a regulatory program for the three new professions.

Mr. Dick explained that HB 3134 and SB 1270 mandated that Roles of DPOR\_and DPOR and VDH work together to establish the new regulatory VDH One of the professions, Authorized Onsite Soil Evaluator, is currently regulated by VDH and must transfer smoothly to DPOR to prevent any disruption in the availability of qualified practitioners to the public. Alternative Onsite Sewage System Installers and Alternative Onsite Sewage System Operators are not currently regulated. All three must be properly qualified to perform tasks in compliance with VDH regulations, thus the importance of VDH involvement throughout the process. Mr. Dick explained that the challenge ahead of the Committee Challenge and the Board is to develop draft regulations to the set appropriate education, experience, examination, and performance/discipline standards for the newly-regulated professions.

Mr. Dick explained that any examination to be used to determine **Examination** entry level competence for any license must be developed by a vendor capable of employing psychometric principles to develop a valid and defensible examination or examinations.

Mr. Dick reviewed with the Committee the one comment NOIRA received in response to the Board's Notice of Intended Regulatory Comment Action

Chairperson Vanderland opened the floor for public comment. A Public Comment number of the sixteen or so individuals made comments and Period offered advice. The Committee continued to take comments from those present throughout the remainder of the meeting.

The Committee proceeded to draft possible regulation provisions using a regulation outline prepared by Mr. Dick for the Committee's use.

Mr. Alexander briefed the Committee on the current VDH requirements to become an Authorized Onsite Soil Evaluator, which formed the basis for Committee discussion.
