CVS/PHARMACY #10746  
Permit No. 0201-004759 Clayton Cassone, Pharmacy District Manager, appeared as a representative of CVS/Pharmacy #10746 to discuss allegations that it may have violated certain laws and regulations governing the conduct of a pharmacy as stated in the April 3, 2023, Notice and continued by letter dated May 9, 2023. They were represented by Nathan Brand, III, Esquire and Margaret Hardy, Esquire.

Closed Meeting: Upon a motion by Mrs. Richards-Spruill, and duly seconded by Dr. Yuan, the Committee unanimously voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to Virginia Code § 2.2-3711(A)(27) for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of CVS/Pharmacy #10746. Additionally, she moved that Mykl Egan and Ileita Redd attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.

Reconvene: Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed meeting met the requirements of Virginia Code § 2.2-3712, the Committee reconvened in open meeting and announced the decision.

Reconvene:


