Registration no. 0214-001369** Todd Donnelly, Vice President of Compliance, appeared to discuss allegations that Tabula Rasa Healthcare Group dba CareKinesis (“CareKinesis”) may have violated certain laws and regulations pertaining to the practice of pharmacy, as stated in the Notice dated May 28, 2024, and continued by letter dated July 12, 2024. CareKinesis was represented by Theresa DeAngeles, Esq. and Hans Riede, Esq.

CLOSED MEETING: Upon a motion by Mrs. Richards-Spruill, and duly seconded by Dr. Yuan, the Committee unanimously voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to Virginia Code § 2.2-3711(A)(27) for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of CareKinesis. Additionally, she moved that Mykl Egan and Nicole Copeland attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.
