Mr. Kelly, Chair, called the meeting to order at 9:14 a.m.

Call to Order

Mr. Kelly advised the Section members of the emergency evacuation procedures.

Mr. Stone moved to approve the agenda. Mr. Zmuda seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Allen, Anglin, Kelly, Nair, Stone and Zmuda.

Approval of Agenda

The Section agreed by consensus that Ms. Nosbisch contact Virginia Department of Transportation and Virginia Department of Environmental Quality to check the status of a meeting date.

Signing & Sealing of BMP As-Built Plans Language and DEQ Discussion

The Section reviewed the National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB) background information and the recommendation and agreed by consensus to accept the proposed language as amended from the State Corporation Commission

<u>Industrial</u>

Exemption NTSB

<u>54.1.402</u>

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(SCC) to address the change in the Industrial Exemption § 54.1-401 for design of gas pipeline facilities. The SCC language reads: This subsection does not apply to engineering services rendered in connection with gas pipeline facilities as defined in the federal regulations promulgated under 49 U.S.C § 60101 et seq., as amended and adopted by the Commission, and the federal pipeline safety laws. The Section agreed by consensus to add this item to the Board meeting agenda immediately following today's Section meeting. Mr. Stone stated that the Board is not advocating for or against the pipeline, the Board requests that a professional engineer be involved in the design of the pipeline. Ms. Nosbisch stated it would require a change in statute and would need to be placed on DPOR's list of proposed bills if approved by the Director.

The Section agreed to table this item.

Ms. Nosbisch stated the Board submitted a guidance document, but then it was noted that it was not the Board's guidance document to approve because it contained a Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) regulation. At the July 2, 2019 Board meeting, the Board voted to ask VDOT to consider releasing an Internal Memorandum (IM) regarding § 33.1-105 Evidence as to Existence of a Public Highway. VDOT incorporated the document prepared by the Land Surveyor Section into VDOT's survey manual. Ms. Anglin revised the APELSCIDLA Board's document that was previously written and addressed it to the APELSCIDLA Board's regulation which was reviewed at today's meeting. The Section agreed by consensus that staff make the suggested changes to the document and send it to the Land Surveyor Section for review. The item will be placed on the March 17, 2020 Board meeting agenda.
