Ms. Nosbisch stated that Ms. Stokes sends her regrets, and Mr. Allen is expected. Mr. Crowther seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Alexander, Anglin, Boynton, Crowther, Kelly, Langelotti, Price, Reynes, Rios, Snetter, Stiles, Stone, and Zmuda.

There was no public comment.

Public Comment Period

Ms. Nosbisch noted the Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors Section originally reviewed the file at its meeting on May 8, 2018. The Section recommended the file be investigated further and it was referred to the full Board to be reviewed at its meeting on June 13, 2018. The Board agreed with the findings of the Section and referred the file back to Investigations for more information. During this process, Elizabeth Peay, Assistant Attorney General, was contacted and she advised that due to the three year statute of limitations, the matter could not be investigated further; Therefore, the file was again presented with the original information.

File Number 2017-02479, John Erwin Krobath

Regarding **File Number 2017-02479**, John Erwin Krobath was present to address the Board. The Board members reviewed the record of the Informal Fact-Finding Conference, which consisted of the investigative file, transcripts and exhibits, and the Summary of the Informal Fact-Finding Conference as well as the Presiding Officer’s recommendation. Mr. Stone moved to accept the Summary of the Informal Fact-Finding Conference as to the facts, which cites the following violation of the Board’s regulations:

18VAC10-20-760.B.1 (Count 1). Mr. Kelly seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Alexander, Anglin, Boynton, Crowther, Kelly, Langelotti, Price, Reynes, Rios, Snetter, Stiles, and Stone. As the Technical Reviewer, Board member, Mr. Zmuda was not present for the discussion or vote.

Ms. Nobsch indicated that there have been no prior disciplinary actions against Mr. Kroboth. Mr. Stone moved to accept the Summary of the Informal Fact-Finding Conference as to the sanctions, and impose the following: \$150 for the violation contained in Count 1. Mr. Boynton seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Alexander, Anglin, Boynton, Crowther, Kelly, Langelotti, Price, Reynes, Rios, Snetter, Stiles, and Stone. As the Technical Reviewer, Board member, Mr. Zmuda was not present for the discussion or vote.

For these violations, Mr. Worsley agrees to pay the following monetary penalties: \$250 for the violation contained in Count 1; \$250 for the violation contained in Count 2; \$1,000 for the violation contained in Count 3; \$2,000 (\$1,000 for each violation) for the violations contained in Count 4; \$2,000 for the violation contained in Count 5; \$150.00 in Board costs, for a total monetary penalty of \$5,650. In addition for violations of Counts 3, 4, and 5, Mr. Worsley agrees to revocation of his license. Mr. Crowther seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Alexander, Anglin, Boynton, Crowther, Kelly, Price, Reynes, Rios, Snetter, Stiles, Stone, and Zmuda. As the presiding Board member, Ms. Langelotti was not present for the discussion or vote.

Mr. Kelly seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Alexander, Anglin, Boynton, Crowther, Kelly, Price, Reynes, Rios, Snetter, Stiles, Stone, and Zmuda. As the presiding Board member, Ms. Langelotti was not present for the discussion or vote.

Mr. Boynton seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Alexander, Anglin, Boynton, Crowther, Langelotti, Price, Reynes, Rios, Snetter, Stiles, Stone, and Zmuda. As the presiding Board member, Mr. Kelly was not present for the discussion or vote.

Regarding **File Number 2018-01848, BC Architects Engineers LLC**, the Board members reviewed the Consent Order as seen and agreed to by BC Architects Engineers LLC. Mr. Crowther moved to accept the Consent Order which cites the following violation of the Board's regulations: 18VAC10-20-790.8 (Count 1). For this violation, BC

Architects Engineers LLC agrees to pay the following monetary penalties: \$750 for the violation contained in Count 1; and \$150.00 in Board costs, for a total monetary penalty of \$900. Mr. Boynton seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Alexander, Anglin, Boynton, Crowther, Langelotti, Price, Reynes, Rios, Snetter, Stiles, Stone, and Zmuda. As the presiding Board member, Mr. Kelly was not present for the discussion or vote.

The EIC language was reviewed and approved at the June 13, 2018 Board meeting. Ms. Nosbisch reported she spoke with Garrett Moore, Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) Chief Engineer, and he indicated they had been talking to the industry, and the feedback has been limited and project specific.

Mr. Stone moved to approve the language. Mr. Boynton seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Alexander, Anglin, Boynton, Crowther, Kelly, Langelotti, Price, Reynes, Rios, Snetter, Stiles, Stone, and Zmuda. Mr. Stone and Mr. Kelly stated the language was an improvement; it is better than what the federal government requires. The Board requested Board staff send correspondence to VDOT thanking them for their collaboration on the language.

The Board reviewed the response template at the June Board meeting, and it was reviewed again at the PE-LS Section meeting in August. Ms. Nosbisch reported that counsel stated it is not appropriate for the Board to send a response to the solicitation, but it is acceptable for individuals to send a response to a solicitation. Mr. Kelly requested this be discussed further with counsel. Mr. Flaherty will follow-up with Ms. Peay.

Ms. Nosbisch stated that John Palatiello, Executive Director, of Virginia Association of Surveyors (VAS), requested the Board send the guidance document to other agencies. Ms. Anglin moved that Board staff inform VAS they may share the Board's guidance document in correspondence to the other agencies or professional membership organizations. Mr. Zmuda seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Alexander, Anglin, Boynton, Crowther, Kelly, Langelotti, Price, Reynes, Rios, Snetter, Stiles, Stone, and Zmuda.

The Board recessed from 11:08 a.m. until 11:18 a.m.

Ms. Anglin provided an update on the Land Surveyor Apprenticeship Committee meeting. She reported that Department of Labor and Industry (DOLI) and the Land Surveyor Apprenticeship Committee reached a compromise on using 150 hours of Related Technical Instruction (RTI).

Ms. Anglin moved to remove the 30 hour project from Surveying 2, and add the 30 hour project back in for Surveying 5. Mr. Zmuda seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Alexander, Anglin,

Boynton, Crowther, Kelly, Langelotti, Price, Reynes, Rios, Snetter, Stiles, Stone, and Zmuda.

Ms. Anglin suggested multiple changes to the RTI log. She stated, as it stands now, it may be too restrictive. She suggested sending it to the PE-LS Section meeting in November. The Board concurred to place this item on the Professional Engineers and Land Surveyor (PE-LS) Section meeting agenda for November 6, 2018.

The Board concurred to place this item on the PE-LS Section meeting agenda for November 6, 2018.

Ms. Nosbisch reported the PE-LS Section approved the NSPS CST program at its meeting in August. Ms. Anglin moved that the NSPS CST Level IV, with no other education presented, be awarded eight years of approved surveying experience and access to the Fundamentals Surveyor exam; falling under regulation 18VAC10-20-300.A.7. Mr. Zmuda seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Alexander, Anglin, Boynton, Crowther, Kelly, Langelotti, Price, Reynes, Rios, Snetter, Stiles, Stone, and Zmuda.

Ms. Nosbisch reported the following business entities were issued Business Agreements for Registration:

- Osmose Utilities Services Inc., License# 0407007408, signed August 8, 2018
- CDI Corporation, License # 0407005213, signed August 14, 2018
- Integrity Engineering for Development Services, Inc., License# 0407007468, signed August 30, 2018

There were no requests for waiver of continuing education.

Discussion was held on HB 883, part of the red-tape regulatory reform, which directs Department of Planning and Budget (DPB) to administer a three-year regulatory reduction pilot program aimed at reducing by 25% the regulations and regulatory requirements, as defined in the bill, of the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation and the Department of Criminal Justice Services by July 1, 2021. Ms. Nosbisch informed the Board a baseline of current regulations is to be established by October 1, 2018.

Ms. Nosbisch stated that back in September 2017, DPB had a concern with a few of the proposed changes and suggested pulling them from the Regulatory Package so the remainder of the Package could proceed forward through the regulatory process. The DPB suggested the removal of changes

to 18VAC10-20-20, 18VAC10-20-150, 18VAC10-20-270, 18VAC10-20-360, 18VAC10-20-450, 18VAC10-20-505, and 18VAC10-20-300. Ms. Nosbisch suggested the Board wait until after the currently submitted proposed regulations were passed, then revisit the need for these further regulatory changes. The Board agreed by consensus to wait to submit the changes to the above regulations, and file a separate NOIRA to address these regulations, after the currently submitted proposed regulations were approved.

Ms. Stiles reviewed the licensee counts as of August 1, 2018: APELSCIDLA Businesses 4,088; Architects 7,422; Engineers 28,836; Land Surveyors 1,289; Land Surveyors B 77; Land Surveyor Photogrammetrists 118; Interior Designers 495; and Landscape Architects 921.

Licensed and Certified Population

Mr. Stone left the meeting at 11:44 a.m.

Departure of Board Member

Ms. Nosbisch stated the financial statements were provided for informational purposes. Mr. DeBoer stated DPOR boards strive for a ten percent above or below the Callahan Act. He discussed the reasons for a surplus of non-general funds.

Financial Statements

Ms. Nosbisch reported Jerry Carter, CEO of NCEES, is retiring at the end of the month; David Cox, former Kentucky Executive Director, will be replacing him.

NCEES Updates

The next NCEES exams are scheduled for October 26 and 27th.

Board members provided an update from the annual meeting in August. Ms. Anglin provided stated she attended the surveying forum and was disturbed by the number of professional surveys performed without a license. Software is being used to provide the service that should be a licensed professional. Mr. Zmuda stated he learned a lot of perspectives. Mr. Kelly stated eighteen boards are decoupling experience, and the BIM articles were pulled from the agenda and defeated.

Ms. Nosbisch, Mr. Boynton, and Ms. Snetter attended the annual meeting in June. The 100 year anniversary will be in 2019 in Washington, D.C. Mr. Boynton stated NCARB is working on their business model.

NCARB Updates

The last day for ARE 4.0 was June 30th.

Ms. Nosbisch attended the Model Law Task Force meeting in August; the Symposium in 2020 will be held at University of Virginia; Mr. Boynton and she will be attending the MBC/MBE Leadership Summit in October. Ms. Nosbisch and Mr. Boynton will be presenting at the Architectural Exchange in November.

Ms. Alexander will be representing the Board at the annual meeting in November.

CIDQ Updates

Ms. Nosbisch attended the ASLA-CLARB Licensure Summit June 22-24, 2018, where she co-presented with Mike Fox, President of the Virginia Chapter of the American Society of Landscape Architects (ASLA).

Ms. Nosbisch presented at the Virginia ASLA annual Conference August 24-25, 2018. Mike Fox will be sending a representative to the December APELSCIDLA Board meeting.

Mr. Crowther will be representing the Board at the CLARB annual Meeting September 27-29, 2018.

Mr. Zmuda seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Alexander, Anglin, Boynton, Crowther, Kelly, Langelotti, Price, Reynes, Rios, Snetter, Stiles, and Zmuda.

Other Business

The Board reviewed the joint statement from CIDQ, CLARB, NCARB, and NCEES.

The Board reviewed the email from Mr. Westermann, Assistant Attorney General, regarding signing and sealing of cover sheets.

1. Can the Board provide guidance on the effect of the Compilation Engineer's seal, signature, and date on the cover sheet of the aggregate collection of final documents for the project? *After review and discussion, the Board agreed by consensus that the professional responsible for compilation is responsible to make sure the aggregate collection of final documents is complete in accordance with regulations. That individual's responsibility does not supersede the professional responsibility of other professionals involved in the same project.*
2. Does the Board view the Compilation Engineer as accepting professional responsibility for the aggregate collection of final documents for the project? *After review and discussion, the Board agreed by consensus, no, and the Board does not recognize the term "Compilation Engineer."*

Ms. Langelotti moved that Board staff send correspondence to Mr.

Westermann providing the Board's answers to his questions. Ms. Anglin seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Alexander, Anglin, Boynton, Crowther, Kelly, Langelotti, Price, Reynes, Rios, Snetter, Stiles, and Zmuda.

Ms. Nosbisch asked if Board members were interested in changing the meeting start time to 10:00 a.m. This item will be placed on the agenda and discussed again at the December 5, 2018 meeting.

Ms. Nosbisch asked if the Board members were interested in physically signing certificates for each of the professions. Currently, the signatures are scanned into the system. There was a request for a more professional signature. This item will be placed on the agenda and discussed again at the December 5, 2018 meeting.
