As-Built Plans

"The operator shall submit a construction record drawing for permanent stormwater management facilities to the VSMP authority in accordance with 9VAC25-870-108 and 9VAC25-870-112. The record drawing shall contain a statement signed by a professional registered in the Commonwealth of Virginia pursuant to Chapter 4 of Title 54.1 of the Code of Virginia, stating that to the best of their knowledge, the construction record drawing shows all adjustments and revisions to the Stormwater Management Plan made during construction and serve as a permanent record of the actual location of all constructed elements."
