Call to Order

Mr. Clark moved to approve the agenda as written. Mr. Boyd seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Boyd, Clark, and Fauber.

Approval of Agenda

Duncan Abernathy of VSAIA was present to address the Section regarding AIA's research on individuals and businesses advertising in the Yellow Pages and holding themselves out as architects. Mr. Fauber also informed the Section that the electronic version of the 6-month rule has been in place since April. Mr. Fauber stated that this has been a time saver and IDP information has already been submitted.

Public Comment Period

Regarding File Number 2008-03470, Robert R. Hollendonner, the Section members reviewed the Consent Order as seen and agreed to by Mr. Hollendonner. Mr. Boyd recommended that the Board accept the Consent Order in which Mr. Hollendonner admits to a violation of 18 VAC 10-20-790.A.3 of the Board's regulations. For this violation Mr. Hollendonner agrees to a \$1,000.00 fine as well as \$150.00 in Board costs, for a total monetary penalty of \$1,150.00. Mr. Clark seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Clark and Boyd. As the reviewing Board member, Mr. Fauber was not present during the discussion or vote.
