### 18VAC50-30-40. Evidence of ability and proficiency

Marjorie King, Executive Director informed the Board below is for discussion purposes and no action is required. If the Board determines that action is warranted, the Board will consider amending the current individual eligibility regulatory action at the appropriate time.

Subsection A in 18 VAC 50-30-40 of the Individual License and Certification Regulations outline the requirements for applicants for examination to be licensed as a journeyman.

18 VAC 50-30-40 A (3) states "An associate degree or a certificate of completion from at least a twoyear program in a tradesman-related field from an accredited community college or technical school as 18VAC50-30-40. Evidence of ability and proficiency Contractor Board Meeting Minutes October 24, 2023 Page 37 of 38

evidenced by a transcript from the educational institution and two years of practical experience in the trade for which licensure is desired."

Historically, this regulation was applied by requiring the applicant to hold an associate degree or certificate of completion from a two-year program in the same tradesman-related field from an accredited community college or technical school. For example, an individual holding an electrical engineering associate degree with two years of practical electrical experience would meet this requirement and be eligible for the journeyman electrical examination.

After further review, and discussion with the Office of Attorney General, 18 VAC 50-30-40 A (3) allows an individual desiring to obtain eligibility for a journeyman exam to hold an associate degree or certificate from a two-year program in any trade-related field, yet the experience must be in the trade in which the individual seeks to obtain licensure. For example, and individual holding an electrical engineering associate degree with two years of practical plumbing experience would meet the requirement and be eligible for the journeyman plumbing examination.

A motion was made by Mr. Spencer and seconded by Mr. Johnson to have staff bring this topic and concern back to the board once the Executive Branch Review was completed for the proposed individual eligibility regulatory action.
