CALL TO ORDER: A Special Conference Committee ("Committee") of the Board of Psychology ("Board") convened on August 10, 2016 at 10:00 a.m., at the Department of Health Professions, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Richmond, Virginia, Training Room 2.




ADJOURN: With all business concluded, the Committee adjourned at 12:00 p.m.
