deliberations.

RECONVENE:

Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed session met the requirements of § 2.2-3712 of the *Code of Virginia*, the Committee reconvened in open session and announced its

decision.

DECISION:

Upon a motion by Dr. Paulson, and duly seconded by Mr. Salay, the Committee made certain findings of facts and conclusions of law and voted to offer Ms. Sample a Consent Order for indefinite

suspension of her license in lieu of a formal hearing. The motion carried.

ADJOURN:

With all business concluded, the Committee adjourned at 10:54 a.m.

As provided by law this decision shall become a Final Order thirty (56) days after service of such Order on the respondent, unless the respondent makes a written request to the Board within such time for a formal hearing on the allegations made. If service of the Order is made by mail, three (3) additional days shall be added to that period. Upon such timely request for a formal hearing, the decision of the Special Conference Committee shall be vacated.
