The applicant was approved to start her internship.

Eric Olson, Executive Director shared with the Board that staff had reviewed <u>license examinations</u> because of the suspected exam breach scenario. There was not enough evidence to pursue this further so staff closed the case. The Board discussed this and suggests that staff continue to monitor the exams for possible breach and make the Board aware if staff feels there is a possible exam comprise.

Old Business

Chart Requirements

Captain Orr shared with members present that he had not had time enough to complete his report that he wants to share with the Board and he wants to provide this information at the January 15, 2015 meeting. All present agreed and no vote was necessary.

Reciprocity Agreements

New Business

Mindy Spruill discussed reciprocity with the Board. Mr. Holzbach headed up a brief spirited discussion. The Board determined following the discussion to defer this until the next meeting.

Discussion on Interns from other states

Ms. Spruill and the Advisory Board discussed interns from another state. The members decided to bring this scenario up in their next annual conference and then bring back the recommendations to the Advisory Board for review.

Criminal History Matrix

Mindy Spruill and Eric Olson discussed the possibility of the Polygraph Advisory Board having a criminal history matrix to assist staff with reviewing applications. Advisory Board members considered a Board for contractor's criminal history application review matrix and asked Ms. Spruill if staff could take the advisory board's suggestions and recommendations and prepare a Criminal history matrix for the Polygraph Advisory Board to consider. Ms. Spruill will draft proposed matrix for Polygraph Board and bring it back to the next meeting.

Reciprocity Agreements – West Virginia and Michigan

Advisory Board members discussed this matter and determined they would keep the West Virginia reciprocity agreement and defer consideration of the Michigan reciprocity agreement proposal until the January 2015 meeting.

Regulatory Review

Ms. Spruill asked if the board wished to open a regulatory review. The unanimous decision of the group was to wait until 2015 and address it then.

State Regulations for Examinations

Captain Orr shared that he is requesting additional time to prepare his report. He will create an executive summary of written suggestions of requirements for this matter. He will send it to staff. Staff will then disseminate the information to Advisory Board members for review prior to the January 15th, 2015 meeting.
