### POLYGRAPH EXAMINERS ADVISORY BOARD Final MINUTES OF MEETING April 24, 2014

The Polygraph Examiners Advisory Board met on Thursday, April 24, 2014, at the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation, 9960 Mayland Drive, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Richmond, Virginia.

Call To Order

**Mr. Patterson** offered a motion to approve the agenda with the addition of two items for consideration. Items to add: Complaint update by Nick Christner as agenda item 6 d under new business and Review of types of Charts as 6 e. **Mr. Orr** seconded the motion, which was approved unanimously. Members voting "Yes" were: Ingram, Orr and Patterson.

**Approval of the Agenda** 

After the minutes from the Board's October 17, 2013 meeting was reviewed, **Mr. Orr** offered a motion to approve the October 17, 2013 meeting minutes. **Mr. Patterson** seconded the motion, which was approved unanimously. Members voting "Yes" were: Ingram, Orr and Patterson.

Approval of October 17, 2013 Meeting Minutes

There was no public comment.

**Public Comment** 

Mindy Spruill, Regulatory Board Administrator shared with the Board that the new Polygraph Regulations effective January 1, 2014 are available. Copies were distributed to each person present.

Old Business

### A. Commonwealth of Virginia Polygraph Examiners License Examination

**New Business** 

Mindy Spruill provided the Polygraph Board members with a status update on the license examinations. Ms. Spruill distributed the charts to the Advisory Board members. Advisory Board members will need to review the charts. The candidates were testing and Rhonda Starr and Deborah Ogram were proctoring the exams. After the chart review and completion of the test Board members will interview the candidates. Ms. Spruill also shared that 5 licenses were issued in error and the license holders were contacted and two of those persons were testing today.

Mr. Ingram opened the floor for discussion of its state regulations for examinations. A handout was provided for review and consideration. Members shared in the discussion and Mr. Olson, Executive Director offered some historical notes to the members. He shared that approximately 8 years ago the Board reviewed the charts required for the exam and determined that the three charts should be for criminal cases.

After additional discussion Mr. Orr shared that he will create an executive summary of written suggestions of requirements for this matter. He will send it to staff. Staff will then disseminate the information to Advisory Board members for review prior to the October 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2014 meeting.

#### D. Complaint Update

Acting Director, Nick Christner briefed the Board regarding a potential exam security breach. There was much discussion. Some items mentioned for consideration were: redoing the examination and staff shared this would cost potentially \$20,000; the other consideration mentioned was adjusting the test bank questions. After much discussion the Board decided to request Nick Christner to investigate further and bring back numbers for consideration. Mr. Christner shared he felt obligated to share with the Board without comprising the outcome of the ongoing investigation. On this note the Board thanked Mr. Christner and shared they would await his updated report at its October 23<sup>rd</sup> meeting.

#### B. Intern Supervisor - Equivalence Requested

Chairman Ingram requested the Board to review the application of Patrick J. Roche. They were provided a copy for review. Mr. Orr motioned to approve the Polygraph Intern Supervisor License for Mr. Roche based on the information provided in the application and in 18 VAC 120-30-60. Mr. Patterson seconded the motion.

Members voting "Yes" were: Orr, Ingram and Patterson.

Chairman Ingram requested the Board to review the application of Donna J. Turner and they did. Mr. Orr motioned to approve the Polygraph Intern Supervisor License for Ms. Turner based on the information provided in the application and in 18 VAC 120-30-60. Mr. Patterson seconded the motion.

Members voting "Yes" were: Orr, Ingram and Patterson.

### C. General Regulatory Review

Mr. Ingram opened the floor for discussion. The Board was provided a handout for consideration. Advisory Board members discussed: ethical violations, complaints and license suspension in great detail. It was determined that many of the items of concern were addressed in the 4 new prohibited acts that were added to the regulations effective January 1, 2014.
