**Subject:** Letter of Assurance for Amendments to Regulations – Board for Contractors Temporary Certification of Elevator Mechanics found at 18 VAC 50-30

---

I have reviewed the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation’s (the Department) Board for Contractors Temporary Certification of Elevator Mechanics found at 18 VAC 50-30 that was posted on the Virginia Regulatory Town Hall on December 5, 2024. In my view, as counsel to the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation and the Board for Contractors, these regulations may be amended pursuant to Title 54.1 of the *Code of Virginia*. The regulations do not appear to conflict with the Constitution of the United States or the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Virginia, nor do they appear to conflict with any federal or state law currently in effect. The regulations also appear to qualify for the fast-track rulemaking process under § 2.2-4012.1 of the *Code of Virginia* because they are expected to be noncontroversial.

This memorandum addresses legal matters only and is not intended to serve, nor should it be construed, as a comment for or against the merits of the proposed regulations.
