The action is being taken as a result of the legislative mandate to create a sports betting regulatory program to be administered by the Virginia Lottery. These regulations implement a self-exclusion program for individuals who voluntarily agree to refrain from playing account-based lottery games, participating in sports betting, and participating in gaming activities administered by the Office of Charitable and Regulatory Programs and the Virginia Racing Commission. The regulations contain the requirements for sports betting platform operators and their principals, suppliers, vendors and employees, including the permit application and vetting process, operational standards and oversight, and related enforcement procedures. The regulations also outline the measures required to be taken by sports betting platform operators to provide consumer protections to sports bettors.
