**SUBJECT:** Regulations for Obtaining Information from the Virginia DNA Data Bank and Procedures for

Verifying the Identity and Authority of Persons Requesting Information from the Virginia DNA

Data Bank – 6 VAC 40-60 et seq.

In response to a request from the Department of Forensic Science and Forensic Science Board, I have reviewed the proposed regulations, 6 VAC 40-60 *et seq.*, relating to obtaining information from the Virginia DNA data bank and procedures for verifying the identity and authority of persons requesting information from the Virginia DNA data bank. Virginia Code § 19.2-310.5 requires the Department to adopt regulations governing the methods of obtaining information from the data bank and adopt regulations governing the procedures for verification of the identity and authority of the requestor. Virginia Code § 9.1-1110(A)(1) requires the Forensic Science Board to adopt regulations, pursuant to the Administrative Process Act (§ 2.2-4000 et seq.), for the administration of Virginia Code § 19.2-310.5. Upon review of the aforesaid regulations, I find the proposed regulation to be constitutional, consistent with the statutory authority granted by Virginia Code § 19.2-310.5 of the Code of Virginia, and in conformity with existing statutory provisions.
