Subject: Letter of Assurance for Amended Regulations for Condominium Registration - Amend Declarant

Trade or Fictitious Name Requirements — found at 18 VAC48-30

I have reviewed the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation, Common Interest Community Board's proposed Amended Regulations for Condominium Registration - Amend Declarant Trade or Fictitious Name Requirements — found at 18 VAC48-30 that was posted on the Virginia Regulatory Town Hall on March 18, 2020. In my view, as counsel to the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation and the Common Interest Community Board, these regulations may be promulgated pursuant to Title 54.1 of the Code of Virginia. Further, I certify that the proposed changes are exempt from the Administrative Process Act under Code of Virginia § 2.2-4006(A)(4)(c) as they are necessary to conform to changes in Virginia statutory law or the appropriation act where no agency discretion is involved. This
