Subject: Letter of Assurance for proposed changes to 1 VAC 20-70-10 through 1 VAC 20-70-50. Absentee Voting

I have reviewed the State Board of Election's proposed amendments to its Regulations, particularly 1 VAC 20-70-10 through 1 VAC 20-70-50 that were most recently posted on the Virginia Regulatory Town Hall on December 17, 2013. In my view, as counsel to the State Board of Elections, these regulations may be promulgated pursuant to Title 24.2 of the *Code of Virginia*. Moreover, this regulatory action is exempt from the Administrative Process Act pursuant to §2.2-4002-B.8 as it relates to the conduct of elections. The proposed amendments to the regulations do not appear to conflict with the Constitution of the United States or the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Virginia, nor do they appear to conflict with any federal or state law currently in effect. This memorandum addresses legal matters only and is not intended to serve, nor should it be construed, as a comment for or against the merits of the proposed regulations.
