PROPOSED REGULATIONS

<u>**Title of Regulation:**</u> 18 VAC 85-20-10 et seq. Regulations Governing the Practice of Medicine, Osteopathy, Podiatry, Chiropractic, and Physician Acupuncture.

Statutory Authority: § 54.1-2400 and Chapter 29, (§ 54.1-2900 et. seq.) of Title 54.1 of the Code of Virginia

Effective Date:

<u>Summary:</u> These regulations protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Commonwealth by establishing requirements and fees for initial license, license renewal, reinstatement of a lapsed license and approval of foreign medical schools that teach the healing arts.

- A. Unless otherwise provided, fees established by the board shall not be refundable.
- B. All examination fees shall be determined by and made payable as designated by the board.
- C. The application fee for licensure in medicine, osteopathy, <u>and podiatry</u>, or chiropractic shall be <u>\$200</u> <u>\$215</u>, and the fee for licensure in chiropractic shall be <u>\$195</u>. The fee for board approval to sit for Part 3 of the United States Medical Licensing Examination without subsequent licensure in Virginia shall be <u>\$150</u> <u>\$85</u>.
- D. The fee for a temporary permit to practice medicine pursuant to § 54.1-2927 B (i) and (ii) of the Code of Virginia shall be \$25 \$30.
- E. The application fee for a limited professorial or fellow license issued pursuant to 18 VAC 85-20-210 shall be \$125 \$55. The annual renewal fee shall be \$25 \$35. An additional fee for late renewal of licensure shall be \$15.
- F. The <u>application</u> fee for a limited license to interns and residents pursuant to 18 VAC 85-20-220 shall be <u>\$55</u>. The annual renewal fee shall be <u>\$10</u> <u>\$</u>35 a year. An additional fee for late renewal of licensure shall be <u>\$10</u> <u>\$15</u>.
- G. The fee for a duplicate wall certificate shall be \$25 \$15; the fee for a duplicate license shall be \$10 \$5.

- H. The fee for biennial renewal of license-shall be \$125, \$240 for licensure in medicine, osteopathy and podiatry and \$215 for licensure in chiropractic, due in the licensee's birth month. An additional fee to cover administrative costs for processing a late application shall be \$25 for each renewal application within one renewal cycle shall be \$85 for licensure in medicine, osteopathy and podiatry and \$75 for licensure in chiropractic.
- I. The fee for requesting reinstatement of licensure pursuant to § 54.1-2921 of the Code of Virginia shall be \$750 \$2000.
- J. The application fee for licensure to practice acupuncture shall be \$100 \$55. The biennial renewal fee shall be \$50 \$70, due and payable by June 30 of each even-numbered year.
- K. The fee for reinstatement of a license issued by the Board of Medicine pursuant to § 54.1-2904 of the Code of Virginia, which has expired for a period of two years or more, shall be <u>\$250 \$290 for</u> <u>licensure in medicine, osteopathy and podiatry and \$270 for licensure in chiropractic</u> and shall be submitted with an application for licensure reinstatement.
- L. The fee for a letter of good standing/verification to another jurisdiction for a license shall be \$10.
- M. The fee for certification of grades to another jurisdiction by the board shall be \$25. The fee shall be due and payable upon submitting the form to the board.

N. The fee for a returned check shall be \$25.
