## 18 VAC 85-40-80. Fees.

The following fees are required:

- The application fee, payable at the time the application is filed, shall be \$100
  \$130.
- 2. The biennial fee for renewal of licensure shall be \$50 \$135, payable in each odd-numbered year in the license holder's birth month.
- 3. An additional fee to cover administrative costs for processing a late application may be imposed by the board. The additional fee for late renewal of licensure within one renewal cycle shall be \$10 \$50 for each renewal cycle.
- 4. Lapsed license. The fee for reinstatement of a license issued by the Board of Medicine pursuant to § 54.1-2904 of the Code of Virginia, which has expired lapsed for a period of two years or more, shall be \$100 \$180 and must be submitted with an application for licensure reinstatement.
- 5. The fee for reinstatement of a license pursuant to § 54.1-2921 of the Code of Virginia shall be \$2,000.

- 6. The fee for a duplicate license shall be \$5, and the fee for a duplicate wall certificate shall be \$15.
- 7. The fee for a returned check shall be \$25.
- 8. The fee for a letter of good standing/verification to another jurisdiction shall be \$10; the fee for certification of grades to another jurisdiction shall be \$25.
